Applicants must pass the written exam with a minimum score of 70 percent (70%). Physical agility (PA) testing follows IMMEDIATELY for successful applicants. Bring appropriate workout clothes and shoes. After successful completion of the written exam and physical agility testing, an eligibility list will be established and will remain in effect for twelve months, or until exhausted. Preference may be granted to currently certified Police Officers.

Individuals with disabilities who will need reasonable accommodation in order to complete testing must contact the Civil Service Director at (972) 230-9602 at least two weeks prior to the scheduled test date. Documentation supporting the need for accommodation will be required.
